CAREER AIM:

I have been working as a General Dental Practitioner since graduating in 2004. In December 2006, I moved to the UK and have been working in the same dental practice ever since. Over the past 19 years, I have built strong relationships of trust and rapport with my patients, which is one of the most rewarding aspects of my career.

I have a particular interest in endodontics and take pride in providing advanced endodontic treatments to my patients. This passion led me to complete a one-year endodontic course at Eastman in 2010.
